## **JR's New Spektrum Radios**

If you haven't seen these advertised, JR has introduced these radios to target park flying enthusiasts. They operate on 2.4GHz and allow the user a much cleaner signal to fly with. Because these radios, when turned on, automatically scan 80 available 2.4GHz channels and lock on to two to transmit on, there is no channel number assigned to the transmitter. It's capable of transmitting on all 80

channels and the transmitter selects the channels, not the user.

I realized that this new radio may cause some concern at our flying site because this radio cannot comply with our frequency control board. I have taken the liberty of fixing the problem before it occurs. If you have purchased one of these new radios, you certainly may fly with it at CCRCC. We will designate several of the empty spaces on the frequency board to be marked "2.4 GHz Spektrum". When you are ready to fly, just place your current AMA card in one of the marked slots and go fly. When you are done, simply remove your AMA card just like you would with any other radio.

I am asking that if you have one of these radios that you please comply with the above requirement. This will prevent unnecessary concern (and panic) from members who may not be familiar with this new technology. The placing of the AMA card on the board also serves as the clubs safeguard to ensure all active pilots have current AMA membership.
